

Impact 100 of the Palm Beaches is hosting free information sessions to review its grant guidelines and explain the application process.

In 2020, high-impact grants of up to \$100,000 will be awarded to successful nonprofit applicants in one or more of the following focus areas: Arts & Culture; Education; Environment; Family and Health & Wellness.

After a thorough review process, the grant recipient will be selected by majority vote of all Impact the Palm Beaches members at its Award event. Eligible projects or programs must be implemented and serve residents of Palm Beach County (Lake Worth Road north to the Martin County line). To apply you must be an active 501(c)(3) for a minimum of 19 months.
