BCC Briefs for Sept. 16, 2025

At the Sept. 16, 2025, Board of County Commissioners meeting, the board took the following action:

Administration – directed staff on how to proceed with the recruitment and selection of the position of County Attorney.

Airports – approved Amendment #6 with AECOM Technical Services, Inc., for consulting services for the Department of Airports for various projects in the amount not to exceed \$1.1 million.

Approved First Amendment to Airport Ground Transportation Management Agreement with SP Plus LLC, renewing the term of the agreement for an additional one year for the administration, operation, and management of ground transportation at Palm Beach International Airport in an amount not to exceed \$1.1 million.

Housing & Economic Development – approved, by a 6-0 vote, an Impact Fee Affordable Housing Assistance Program funding award to Pinnacle on Sixth, LLC in the amount of \$283,902 for the Pinnacle on Sixth project, which consists of 92 rental apartments located within the City of Lake Worth Beach. Approved, by a 6-0 vote, proposed Fiscal Year 2025-2026 State Housing Initiatives Partnership Program (SHIP) for affordable housing strategies in the approximate amount of \$7.7 25,605, which is an award reduction \$603,647 from FY 2024-2025 and a Budget Amendment in the amount of \$7,602,625 in the Affordable Housing Trust Fund to align the budget with SHIP grant funding allocation.

Approved, by a vote of 6-0, an Impact Fee Affordable Housing Assistance Program funding award of \$254,876 to the Madison Terrace II project, which consists of 85 rental units located at 821 S. Dixie Highway in Lake Worth Beach.

Approved an Impact Fee Affordable Housing Assistance Program funding award in the amount of \$205,949 to West Palm Beach Baptist Seventh Day Church for the 7th on Haverhill project, which consists of 101 rental units located at 1473 Haverhill Road, an unincorporated area of West Palm Beach.

Approved a Housing Bond Loan Program extension for the Drexel Road Senior Apartments project, entailing new construction of an affordable senior rental development at 1745 Drexel Road in unincorporated West Palm Beach, consisting of 188 rental units.

Palm Tran – approved Program for Projects and Grant Application to provide capital and operating assistance for public transportation projects.
