

According to the most recent statistics from the US Census, did you know there are 18.2 million veterans in the United States? Florida has the third-largest veteran population of 1.5 million. Of that, 17.4 % under the age of 65 are uninsured in our County.

The United States Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) is an agency of the federal government that provides benefits, health care, and cemetery services to military Veterans. There are three branches of the veterans services.

The Veterans Health Administration (VHA) is home to one of the United States' largest integrated health care systems, consisting of 167 medical centers, more than 1,400 community-based outpatient clinics, community living centers, Vet Centers and Domiciliaries.
