On-Demand Play Therapy Workshops!

Child-Centered Group Play Therapy: The focus of this 1.5-hour online training is on using Child-Centered Group Play Therapy (CCGPT) with young children facing social, emotional, behavioral, and relational challenges.

Cost: \$35 (1 hour Play Therapy non-contact APT CE and 1 State of Florida CEU included).

Termination in Play Therapy: Participants of this workshop explore why proper termination matters, learn step-by-step procedures for ending sessions, practice skills for closing the therapist-client relationship, and gather at least three creative play-based activities that promote healthy closure. **Cost: \$25** (1 hour Play Therapy non-contact APT CE and 1 State of Florida CEU included).

Trauma and Play Therapy: This workshop shows how Play Therapy can help children express, process, and heal from trauma. Participants examine trauma's impact on developing brains and families, learn five developmentally tailored play activities, and practice trauma-narrative techniques ready for immediate use.

Cost: \$25 (1 hour Play Therapy non-contact APT CE and 1 State of Florida CEU included).

Play Therapy with Families: This on-demand online workshop focuses on integrating Play Therapy into family sessions. Participants explore developmentally appropriate techniques, ways to support confidentiality in family work, and practical interventions they can apply right away.

Foundation for Addressing the Social-Emotional Wellness of Children Using Play: This on-demand, 10-hour online course builds a solid grounding in Child-Centered Play Therapy (CCPT) for clinicians and educators. Through video modules and real-world examples, participants learn CCPT history and theory, strategies for forging therapeutic relationships, reflective listening, limit-setting, and offering meaningful choices.
