The Florida Network of Care is a behavioral health website which is made up of helpful information, resources and a searchable service directory. #### [HHS awards more than \\$85M to expand oral health care access](#)

HHS recently awarded more than \$85 million to 298 health centers to expand oral health service capacity through new infrastructure enhancements. “These are the first awards HRSA has ever made solely for health centers’ oral health care

infrastructure, and they will support better access to oral health services in communities across the country, including underserved urban and rural areas,” says HHS Secretary Alex Azar.

#### [A Look at the Pennsylvania Rural Health Model](#)

In partnership with the CMS Innovation Center, Pennsylvania’s Department of Health developed [the Pennsylvania Rural Health Model](#) to test whether care delivery transformation and hospital global budgets can increase access to high-quality care, improve health, reduce the growth of hospital expenditures across payers, and improve the financial viability of rural Pennsylvania hospitals. This brief is intended for those exploring or considering global budget or other transformation models for rural hospitals (e.g., state governments considering global budgeting models, hospital associations, rural hospital administrators, federal policymakers, etc.). [Rural Health Value](#) was created in a cooperative agreement with the Federal Office of Rural Health Policy to provide rural-centric expertise and assistance to support high performance rural health systems.

#### [Effective Communication and Consistency in Increasing Rural Vaccination Rates](#)

Vaccination rates for rural children and adolescents are lower than for their urban counterparts. A nurse practitioner in Louisiana and a former professor in Kentucky share how they’ve increased vaccination rates in their communities.

#### [Needs Assessment Methodologies in Determining Treatment Capacity for Substance Use Disorders: Final Report](#)

Presents the results from an environmental scan reviewing the literature on needs assessment methods and substance use disorder (SUD) needs assessment reports representing diverse interests, including rural and urban areas, researchers, government agencies, and private consultants. Highlights best practices for conducting SUD needs assessments, identifies gaps and opportunities for improvement in the available data, and discusses why SUD needs assessments are necessary.

#### [Rural Health Research Recap: Poverty and Health Insurance Coverage Among Rural Children](#)

Provides summaries of recent research on poverty among rural children, their access to insurance, and care available to Medicaid beneficiaries. Features statistics from 2012 on groups covered by Medicaid and distribution of Medicaid enrollment of children by race or ethnicity, with breakdowns by urban, large rural, small rural, or isolated rural location.
