## Child-Centered Group Play Therapy

**Facilitated by Nida Paul, LMHC, NCC, Registered Play Therapist**

The focus of this 1.5-hour workshop is using Child-Centered Group Play Therapy (CCGPT) with young children experiencing social, emotional, behavioral, and/or relational difficulties.

CCGPT is an evidence-based intervention that allows children to experience social interactions to learn, practice, and enhance new social and coping skills.
