

<u>6 Stewardship Strategies to Engage Them</u> *by Jay Love*

The first step to deepening relationships with your donor base is to improve your donor stewardship approach. Donor stewardship is the relationship-building process you use to get to know your donors and strengthen their commitment to your cause. It's especially important to build strong relationships with major donors. Nonprofit survey research shows that 88% of total dollars raised comes from just 12% of donors—these are your major donors. Since these donors contribute the bulk of your funding, you must regularly engage with them and show your appreciation.
