Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (BCC), Community Services Department (CSD), invites eligible entities to submit proposals for the FY 2026 Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for Opioid Settlement Funds (OSF). Proposed programs and services submitted in response to the FY 2026 NOFO for OSF funds should address strategies and best practices that demonstrate positive change toward the Department's goal of stabilizing clients in crisis and moving clients along the recovery-oriented system of care toward building resilient and recovery-ready individuals and communities.

Funding will be distributed for each Category/Subcategory as follows:

Community Education and Engagement Category

Subcategories: Resilient and Recovery Ready Communities

Family Support Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT)

All programs will include Continuous Quality Improvement/Management.

Proposers may submit a Proposal (s) for funding of more than one service/program. The Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) is now available. The deadline to submit a proposal is 12 p.m. on **November 10, 2025.**
