Celebrating 50 Sessions of Criminal Justice Education: The Criminal Justice Academy Begins September 17

The Palm Beach County Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), in partnership with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO), is proud to announce this milestone session of the Citizen's Criminal Justice Academy (CCJA). This <u>special session</u> will run from September 17 through December 17, 2025, meeting each Wednesday evening from 6 to 9 p.m., excluding the week of Thanksgiving.
