CEO's Corner



Dear Supporters & Friends:

"More Than the Dress" helps explain our Dress for Success name. Now it's our Dress for Success *Palm Beaches* name that needs explanation: We're More Than Palm Beach(es).

Our affiliate also has been serving women in Broward County and earlier this year we registered d/b/a Dress for Success Broward County with the Florida Department of State's Sunbiz. Yay! What this means is that we've extended our fundraising scope so that foundations and other philanthropic resources based in Broward can be confidently assured that their allocation is helping to benefit those in their local community.

For the past three years we've been steadily focusing on developing partnerships with several well-respected Broward-based organizations. **Women in Distress** is one that we visit monthly, each time bringing a Road to Success-type session, such as financial literacy, self-image, interviewing skills, etc., to their participants. This relationship has further evolved as we've joined with another Broward agency – **H.O.M.E.S** (Housing Opportunities Mortgage Assistance & Effective Neighborhood Solutions). H.O.M.E.S. arranges for a van to shuttle some of their own participants to our Road to Success series, and Women in Distress clients are invited to ride with them and enroll in a full 6-week RTS term. Another wonderful outcome of these relationships is that several of the WID and H.O.M.E.S. staff have volunteered as RTS mentors – answering a recurring need we have for the one-on-one coaches.

Another of our BC partners: **Center for Healthy Marriages & Families, Inc.** In addition to referring clients to us and assisting them with their transportation, this group introduced us to the Miramar Job Fair. It is considered one of the top 50 such expos in the country because of the caliber of exhibitors it attracts from business and industry. Displaying at Miramar has enabled us to cast our net much further among the women in BC and offer them a valuable resource in preparing for the workforce.

Our RTS facilitator, Dr. Nethel Stephens, is Fort Lauderdale-based. She's been a true catalyst in growing our presence in Broward, involving, as well, **Redeeming Word Ministries**, where she is part of the leadership. Several of her congregants have participated in RTS and attend our PWG programs. And, the church was a '25 Style for Hope sponsor. So, it's been our great fortune to have benefitted in so many ways since our association with Nethel.

If you're wondering, "What about Martin County?" We are fulfilling our affiliate's mandate there via several "Palm Beaches" agency partnerships that are inclusive of our northern neighbor (i.e., Community Foundation for Palm Beach and Martin Counties, Mary's Home of the Treasure Coast). And, let's not forget: All the while that we've been purposefully expanding in Broward, we've been progressively building up our position in "The Glades," serving Belle Glade, Pahokee and South Bay.

It's non-stop expansion met by non-stop responsiveness and commitment – all achieved thanks to your ongoing support.

There's been a lot of talking going on about Dress for Success Palm Beaches thanks to recent Speakers Bureau bookings. Helping to get the word out have been Speakers Bureau Co-Chairs Nancy Rizzuto and Debbie Freire plus our illustrious CEO Joe Ann Fletcher.

Nancy and Debbie have been engaging with Rotary Clubs around the community – and, if you can believe it, there are about a dozen on the Speakers Bureau's hit list. So far, they've presented to memberships in West Palm Beach, Wellington and Town of Palm Beach, acquainting them with our services and programs and enlisting their support via contributions and hosting clothing drives – especially "Power of the Purse."

[FYI, "Power of the Purse" is what we often suggest for organizations and companies that want to show their support via a clothing drive. Since we're generally well-stocked with clothing but frequently have a shortage of handbags for our clients — especially basic black — we offer this concept. "Power of the Purse" brings in gently worn or new ones; and, we encourage donors to add a \$25 gift card or new mascara or lipstick inside the purse. It's proven to be a popular program that's easier for the organizations to manage and beautifully solves our needs, as well.]

Meanwhile, Joe Ann's dance – er, speakers – card most recently was filled at Temple Israel in West Palm Beach. She was invited to help its congregants get through their Yom Kippur fasting period by leading an afternoon conversation about philanthropy and sharing what Dress for Success is all about. She was warmly welcomed by Rabbi Ryan Daniels who led the discussion.

Next up for Joe Ann: She was asked to headline one of the workshops at the Dress for Success Worldwide Conference in Toronto at the end of October.
