

Their licensed Navigators will provide you with FREE, impartial assistance. Special Enrollment Period is now. You may be able to enroll if you have had certain life events such as losing health coverage, getting married, having a baby, moving, etc. If your income is between 100 % - 150% FPL (1person -\$15,560 - \$23,475) you can also enroll during this time.

Palm Beach County Food Bank is the sole provider of the federal waiver to provide comprehensive SNAP outreach in Palm Beach County. Palm Beach County Food Bank is one of only four organizations in Florida that holds the waiver for the full interview process required to qualify for SNAP benefits. Palm Beach County Food Bank has access to the state software program to directly add client information as if the state employed them and conducted all face-to-face interviews.
