## FY26 Tau Grant Information



We are delighted to share Allegany Franciscan Ministries' FY26 Tau Grant Program information with you.

Tau Grants are designed to strengthen the health and well-being of communities across our six-county region. In FY26, Tau Grants will support small nonprofit organizations that **expand access to healthcare services or promote economic mobility**. We prioritize organizations that both serve and are led by people from historically marginalized communities, including BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, and People of Color), LGBTQ+ individuals, people with disabilities, and immigrants. Tau Grants provide unrestricted general operating support to help these organizations thrive. Individual Tau Grant awards will be for a two-year term and may total up to \$20,000.

We will offer two Tau Grant cycles. Each cycle will have one dedicated focus area.

### Cycle 1: Access to Healthcare (Fall 2025)

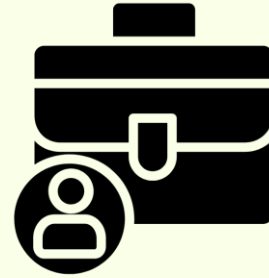
Healthcare access is the ability to obtain healthcare services such as diagnosis, prevention, or treatment, that's affordable and convenient. Examples may include organizations focused on providing health services to underinsured or uninsured individuals, or assisting with health insurance enrollment.

## Cycle 2: Economic Mobility (Spring 2026)

Economic mobility is the ability of individuals to improve themselves and their families' economic condition. Examples may include organizations focused on job training/placement, entrepreneurship, social assistance, or financial literacy.



**Eligibility** To be considered for funding, the organization must meet all of the following requirements:

- The organization has an operating budget of less than \$1M.
- The organization has an IRS ruling date before 1/1/2023 as a 501 (c)(3) nonprofit.
- Serves residents in one or more of the following counties: Miami-Dade, Palm Beach, St. Lucie, Martin, Hillsborough, and Pinellas.
- The organization does not have an active Tau grant.
- At least 50% of the organization's population served includes individuals who identify as BIPOC, LGBTQ+, individuals with a disability, or immigrants.
- Be willing and able to comply with all requirements of Allegany Franciscan Ministries' [grant agreement](#).
- The organization acts in alignment with [Catholic Social Teaching](#).

## Limitations

- Only one application may be submitted for an organization per cycle.
- Tau Grants are not available for individuals, public agencies, capital campaigns, endowments, or reserve funds.
