



Please note these upcoming activities and traffic impacts related to the State Road (S.R.) 80/Southern Boulevard and S.R. 7/U.S. 441 Ramp Improvements Project in the Village of Royal Palm Beach.

Traffic Impacts:

- One northbound lane of S.R. 7/U.S. 441, from Erica Boulevard to north of S.R. 80/Southern Boulevard, may be closed intermittently, Monday, Feb. 23 through Friday, Feb. 27 for striping and erosion control work.
- One northbound outside lane of S.R. 7/U.S. 441, from Erica Boulevard to north of S.R. 80/Southern Boulevard will be closed continuously, from Monday, March 2 until Summer 2026 to accommodate bridge widening on S.R. 7/U.S. 441.
- *Pedestrian detours will be in place with advance notice; please follow directional signage and proceed with caution through the work zone.*
