The City of Belle Glade is advancing stormwater drainage upgrades Airport Park to reduce flooding, protect nearby neighborhoods, and improve field usability. Work is underway and the park remains [open/partially open/closed] in designated areas. What happening

- Installing new underground drainage pipes and
- · Regrading low-lying areas improves water flow
- · Adding drainage swales/bioswales and connection to the existing outfall
- · Restoring turf and pathways after construction
