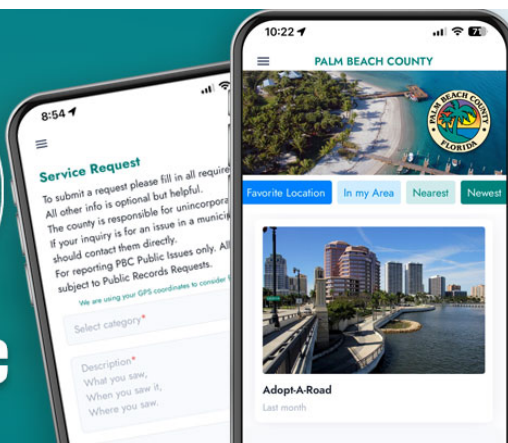

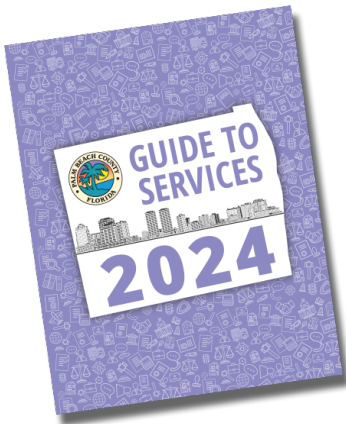
From Jan. 25-26, over 300 staff members and community volunteers participated in the PBC homeless Point-in-Time count.
