County Program Offers up to \$15,000 for Low-Income Residents to Replace Home Air Conditioning Systems

The crisis Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Replacement Program, through LIHEAP (Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program), is available to assist low-income Palm Beach County homeowners in need of replacing their HVAC systems. Residents may receive assistance up to \$15,000 that can be used to replace a home cooling system.

Clients must be income eligible, live in Pam Beach County and able to show that they are in a crisis situation. Completed applications must show one or more of the following:

- · The HVAC system no longer cools
- The HVAC unit is 10 years or older
- · Proof of high energy bills
- Proof of a life-threatening environment via a doctor's statement
